



Corona Virus Plan and Race Information

July 25th practice and July 26th race

Competitors Expectations.

1. Free Spectating will be allowed behind pit fencing. Masks must be worn in bleacher sections (both pit side and Free side), fence line tail gating spectators must follow social distancing guidelines.
2. Each Pit/Team should allow 6-foot social distancing between active pit areas. Recommend alternating direction of active working area from those pitted next to you.
3. All pit entrants must wear a mask or helmet when outside of their pit area when 6-foot social distancing cannot be maintained.
4. Always maintain a 6-foot social distance.
5. All competitors and spectators should bring their own food, drink and trash should be packed out. TRASH CANS ARE FOR HAND WASH STATIONS ONLY. We're sorry for the inconvenience. If you have traveled from out of town and are limited on space to haul out, please contact Jeff Shawver or any senior member and we may be able to help.
6. Bathrooms have hand sanitizer and wash stations are on hand. Please help us keep the bathrooms in good order.
7. If you are having in symptoms of the covid-19 virus you are not allowed to attend. Please take your temperature prior to attending and if you experience any symptoms during the event you are to leave immediately.
8. Drivers meeting will be held at the grid area. We will not clear the pits for the drivers meeting, only one attendee/representative for each kart is needed. We will do the meeting over the speaker system and all in attendance in the pits should listen in.



9. Grid procedure. Please do not gather at pit entrance until the group before you are starting to sit in karts. After karts have left the grid, the next class may push in to drop karts. Flow should be entering from the back of the grid, push empty kart stands through front fence opening to parking area. Only one person and driver on the grid at one time and only stage on B grid. A is always to remain open to allow for fence spectating by driver's parent or one crew to maintain social distancing.
10. Scales are off limits to all but one crew member and driver. Please maintain a 6-foot distance when you remove your helmet. It is recommended that the driver have their mask in a secure suit or jacket pocket, and you must put the mask back on if you remove your helmet at the scales.
11. Tech is off limits to all but one person for each kart. All others are to remain away from the tech area. All representatives must wear a mask.
12. Please keep your distance from race officials because they will be in contact with the most people over the weekend, they will have to be in the elements all day and may not be wearing a mask due to the heat. Please wear a mask if you need to talk to any officials.
13. Registration will be done on motorsportreg.com as much as possible. You will check in at the registration window at the north facing scoring/registration window or as directed at the window for later check in. If you can, please purchase a pit pass for your group on motorsport reg during your race registration if you can but can be purchased on site as well. All forms of payment accepted and please bring exact change for purchases.
14. Awards will be given out after disinfecting, 1st place will be on the podium, 2nd and 3rd will stand to either side of podium for pictures. Mask will be required; individuals may take photos on podium without masks on after awards are presented.
